Driving while impaired with alcohol and/or other drugs is a serious concern. The personal, family and community impact are significant. Also significant is the impact on an extensive range of professionals, agencies and departments. This DWI symposium will address the various organizations and considerations the professionals in those environments contend with when working with DWI offenders. Divided into a keynote presentation followed by 5 moderated panel discussions beginning with arrest and continuing through license restoration, we will examine and discuss the considerations these professionals must keep in mind throughout the performance of their work. The keynote presentation, delivered by Glenn Mathews, will offer the perspective of someone whom has had a DWI and been through several NH DWI programs and processes.

- **Panel 1- Arrest & Law Enforcement**. This panel includes representation from the NH State Police, Division of Liquor Enforcement, local/town police and the Department of Safety Bureau of Hearings. Topics may include DWI laws, BACs, how an arrest is determined, what physically happens during an arrest, detention & release, and liability for the arresting officers.
- **Panel 2- Case Disposition**, will include a judge, prosecutor, defense attorney, public defender, and house of corrections. This panel will examine questions involved with sentencing, serving time, looking at the case and factors when involved with the courts.
- **Panel 3- Impaired Driver Care Management and Driver Education** processes will explain the process of program involvement from beginning to end from the perspective of care managers, education instructors and directors/managers.
- **Panel 4- Impaired Driver Services** programs, which will discuss considerations for individual and group outpatient treatment with DWI offenders, intensive outpatient treatment and inpatient treatment programs. There will be representation from each of these types of services involved with the panel. This panel will also include medication assisted treatment such as methadone and related considerations with this population.
- **Panel 5- License Restoration**. This panel will include the Department of Safety Bureau of Hearings and Bureau of Financial Responsibility, as well as Draeger Diagnostics concerning use of the interlock device.

These will be moderated panels with questions that address considerations when effectively working with this population and then the panel will open up for discussion. By the end of this symposium participants will be able to describe points of consideration for arrest, conviction, treatment and license restoration. They will be able to understand and explain these components to others in the community. They will also be able to identify their role and responsibilities when working with DWI offenders.
