### Sample Messages - Talking to Youth

- Parents and mentors have more influence in promoting substance-free norms than they might realize. Having the talk early and often can prevent young people from using cannabis. - Cannabis, which creates a high through a chemical called THC, can have short- and long-term effects on developing brain function, physical movement, moods, and relationships. What's more, for those who start using cannabis before the age of 18, one in six will develop a cannabis use disorder. ## Sample Messages - Legalization/Decriminalization

- With legalization debates and legislation in NH (and other states), cannabis has become more and more normalized. Yet many aren't aware of the effects it has on our mental health. From worsening long-term conditions like anxiety and depression, to causing severe short-term effects like psychosis and paranoia, there's no such thing as a harmless high. - Since the decriminalization of cannabis in 2017, many (especially teens) reported feeling that using marijuana once or twice a week wasn't a great risk.
